

ORDINANCE No. 183772

*Amend subrecipient contract with Community Energy Project to revise the total contract amount not to exceed \$311,350 for Weatherization Workshops, Senior Weatherization Program and Home Safety Repair Program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000114)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds

1. The City Council passed ordinance #183022 on July 22, 2009 authorizing Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) to execute subrecipient contract #32000114 with Community Energy Project for Weatherization Workshops, Senior Weatherization Program, and Home Safety Repair Program.
2. During the Winter of 2010, the high community demand for weatherization materials resulted in Community Energy Project running out of budgeted materials in February.
3. Additional resources will allow Community Energy Project to provide 300 low-income households with weatherization materials to lower their costs of their utility bills.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Bureau Director and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to revise contract #32000114 with Community Energy Project in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A (attached to original ordinance only).
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the FY 2009-10 budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt Community Energy Project's ability to provide the services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
