

# ORDINANCE No. 183821

\*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Agriculture to revise and publish a new edition of the GardenSmart Oregon booklet (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland was a key partner in the development of the 'GardenSmart Oregon' booklet in 2008, providing financial and technical support. Since then, the booklet has become a crucial component of outreach on the issue of invasive plants. Over 75,000 copies have been distributed.
2. In August 2009, the City Council passed Resolution 36726, which established the Invasive Plants Strategy as the City's management plan for invasive plants. The strategy specifically mentions GardenSmart as an example of City-led outreach on invasive plants.
3. 'GardenSmart Oregon,' a key component of the City's Early Detection/Rapid Response initiative, is to be revised and reprinted. The Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) will direct the Oregon Invasive Species Council to coordinate revision of the existing document and will arrange for publication of approximately 50,000 new booklets. BES will receive approximately 4,500 copies of the reprinted booklet for use in outreach by BES and its partners.
4. The City will make a single payment of \$10,000 for this edition of GardenSmart. Funds are available in the Grey-to-Green and Watershed Services budgets as part of the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Agriculture, acting as fiscal agent for the Oregon Invasive Species Council, for the purpose described in Section 1 in the amount of \$10,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because printing is anticipated by mid-June. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
