

ORDINANCE No. 183822

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$158,000 from Metro's Nature in Neighborhoods Capital Grants Program for Baltimore Woods Connectivity Corridor Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Three Rivers Land Conservancy, in partnership with BES, applied to Metro for a Nature in Neighborhoods Capital Grant in the amount of \$158,000 for Baltimore Woods Connectivity Corridor Project on November 02, 2009; and
2. Metro has notified the Three Rivers Land Conservancy and City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Baltimore Woods Connectivity Corridor Project to BES in the amount of \$158,000.

NOW THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Metro for the Baltimore Woods Connectivity Corridor Project in the amount of \$158,000 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2009/2010 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217007

Business Area - ES00

Bureau Program Expenses – \$7,500

- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


