## ORDINANCE No. **1 8 3 8 5 8**

\* Apply for a \$53,750 grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY10 Bulletproof Vest Partnership for bulletproof vests (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) will provide grant funding for the purchase of bulletproof vests for local law enforcement agencies.
- 2. The City wishes to apply for grant funding for bulletproof vests for 100 law enforcement officers whose vests are due for replacement during the next two years.
- 3. The USDOJ will reimburse the City \$53,750, or a portion thereof, for expenses incurred for the purchase of body armor. The award amount will be based on the overall number of grant requests received by USDOJ.
- 4. The grant requires a 50 percent cash match (up to \$53,750), which will be funded with existing Police Bureau FY2010-11 through FY2011-12 General Fund appropriation for clothing and equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs for the FY2010 Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant in the amount of \$53,750.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.


