* Authorize application for a \$155,445 grant from the U. S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, National Institute of Justice to improve the quality and timeliness of forensic science services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The United States Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), National Institute of Justice (NIJ) Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grants Program will make awards available to units of local government for funding to help improve the quality and timeliness of forensic science services.
- 2. The City of Portland, Oregon Police Bureau wishes to apply for USDOJ OJP NIJ funding in order to move to a fully digital format in its evidence photo processing and archiving to allow for faster turn-around time in processing of photographic evidence.
- 3. The USDOJ will reimburse the Bureau for personnel, equipment and training expenses not to exceed the grant application request of \$155,445. The grant period is October 1, 2010, through September 30, 2011. This grant does not require a match.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Oregon Department of Justice, Crime Victims' Services Division for a grant in the amount of \$80,000 in accordance with the application attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this application may result in not receiving funding. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
