## **ORDINANCE** No. 183864

\*Amend the Intergovernmental Agreement with Columbia County to perform purchase obligations and extend the time period for the distribution of equipment, supplies and services procured as a result of Urban Areas Security Initiative Grant FY 2009 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 52497)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The City of Portland (SUBGRANTEE) has received previous awards for the Urban Areas Security Initiative Grants for FY 2003 FY 2008 totaling \$47,771,838. The City has recently been awarded the FY 2009 UASI Grant in December 2009 in the amount of \$6,581,436 (Ordinance #183409). The UASI grant assists jurisdictions in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, protect against, respond to and recover from acts of terrorism.
- 2. The City of Portland is the designated administrator for the UASI regional grants.
- 3. Administration of this grant will be implemented per the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) as amended here.
- 4. The approved FY 2009 UASI award will extend the IGA to April 30, 2012.

NOW, THERFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No. 52497 between the City and Columbia County as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the attached Amendment No. 4.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive Columbia County and the City of Portland with the benefits of this agreement; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.

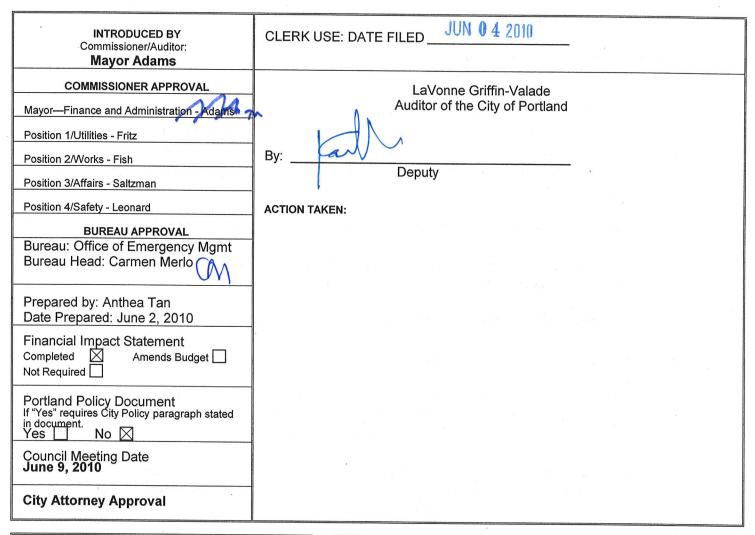
