ORDINANCE NO. 183888

* Accept donation of \$1,000 for the Police Bureau from the Wal-Mart Foundation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Wal-Mart Foundation would like to donate \$1,000 for the use of Police Bureau.
2. The Police Bureau intends to use the funds for outreach and recruitment activities in support of creating a diverse pool of employment candidates.
3. The Chief of Police recommends that the Council accept the donation from the Wal-Mart Foundation.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The City Council accepts the donation of \$1,000 and thanks the Wal-Mart Foundation for its donation.


