ORDINANCE No. 183899

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro and accept a \$30,000 sponsorship to administer five Sunday Parkways (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Metro, through its Regional Travel Options Sub-Committee of JPACT, has awarded the Bureau of Transportation a \$30,000 sponsorship for five Sunday Parkways in 2010.
2. The Vision for the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) calls for a balanced, multi-modal transportation system where residents will have a broad range of safe and convenient transportation options and will frequently walk, bicycle, carpool, or ride public transit as their first choice of transportation.
3. Sunday Parkways is the concept of opening up a network of streets once a week to encourage healthy, active walking and cycling and has proven to be an effective means of promoting active transportation in several cities across the world. In 2009, three Sunday Parkways events drew over 50,000 participants and garnered significant media coverage.
4. The City of Portland and its partners are implementing five Sunday Parkways events in 2010, which will promote walking and bicycling in Portland.
5. The attached Intergovernmental Agreement allows Metro to apportion \$30,000 of the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality funds to the City to administer five Sunday Parkways project.
6. The Intergovernmental Agreement has been reviewed by the City Attorney.
7. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is optimal.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


