

ORDINANCE NO. **183904**

\* Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industry by extending the contract period. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30000898)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. PHB currently has a contract with Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) to provide administrative enforcement of complaints filed under Portland City Code 23.01 since FY 1991-92.
2. PHB desires to extend the contract period to April 15, 2011 to serve additional individuals seeking investigation and enforcement of complaints.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to amend Subrecipient Contract No. 30000898 with BOLI in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A (attached to the original ordinance only).
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said contract from the Portland Housing Bureau General Fund FY 2009-10.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt BOLI's ability to provide Civil Rights Enforcement Services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
