2. The LNA seeks an amendment to the North Reach Plan incorporating a long-term commitment to the exclusion of the Linnton Waterfront from designation as either Prime Industrial Land or as an RSIA. To do otherwise would unduly restrict the options available for the future of our waterfront.
3. The LNA wants the council to support current efforts to create an environmental sanctuary on the Linnton Waterfront. There are several proposals under consideration, one from BP and one from NOAA, which include such a sanctuary. Both proposals have promise and deserve consideration by all involved parties.
