* Accept a \$186,000 grant from the Oregon Department of Justice and the Oregon High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas Program to fund \$56,000 for Portland Police Bureau Metro Gang Task Force efforts and \$130,000 for Portland Interdiction Team efforts (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Department of Justice was awarded \$2,845,000 by the Office of National Drug Control Policy's High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program to support initiatives designed to implement the strategy proposed by the Executive Board of the Oregon HIDTA Program and approved by the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) for Fiscal Year 2010.
- 2. The City of Portland was awarded \$56,000 to support their participation in the Metro Gang Task Force (MGTF) Initiative. This initiative provides the Bureau with the means to assist in the investigation of violent street gang members who are involved in the distribution of controlled substances in the Portland area. The \$130,000 awarded will provide funding to the Portland Police Bureau for efforts in disrupting and dismantling drug trafficking organizations in Multnomah, Washington, and Clackamas Counties by employing a multiagency approach to significantly impact drug availability in the area.
- 3. The Oregon Department of Justice will reimburse the City a maximum of \$186,000 for bureau personnel overtime, travel and program expenses. The grant does not require matching funds.
- 4. The grant period is October 1, 2009, through September 30, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Justice in the amount of \$186,000.
- b. The FY 2009-10 budget is hereby amended as follows:

c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
