

ORDINANCE No.

*Extend contract with Ball Janik LLP to increase contract funds and extend contract for representation in Washington, D.C. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 37302)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City requires the services of a contractor working in Washington, D.C. to advise the City and perform other services for the City in connection with the activities of the federal government.
2. Ball Janik LLP was chosen by the City as its choice for the Contract award based on the criteria set forth in the solicitation process.
3. The City has previously contracted with Ball Janik LLP and received excellent services. This amendment will add \$198,000 to the contract. Funds are available in the Office of Government Relations FY 2010-11 Budget. (GRLG000001 – Acct. 0000521000).
4. It would be beneficial for the City to continue the contract substantially in the form set forth in Amendment No. 2, attached to this ordinance, to continue the provision of such services.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor is authorized to execute on behalf of the City an amendment to Contract No. 37302 with Ball Janik LLP as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the contract amendment attached as Amendment No. 2.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to Government Relations' FY 2010-11 budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the City requires continuous services of a representative in Washington, D.C.; therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


