

**ORDINANCE No. 183930**

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to provide for one half of the costs for facilitation services provided by Sue Dicile, contractor with Multnomah County to the Joint City-County Task Force on animal services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Through the City of Portland's Resolution No. 36569 and Multnomah County's Resolution No. 07-190, a Joint City-County Taskforce was formed to study and develop options to provide animal services in the City that protect health, safety, and welfare of citizens and promote neighborhood livability.
2. Multnomah County entered into a contract with Sue Dicile to provide for facilitation services to the Joint City-County Task Force.
3. This Intergovernmental Agreement is for financial support from the City of Portland for half of the costs of facilitation not to exceed \$8,000.00.
4. One-time funds for this Intergovernmental Agreement are available and already budgeted in the Revenue Bureau's FY2009-2010 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Revenue Bureau Director, Sue Klobertanz, is authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Portland and Multnomah County in a form substantially in accordance with that attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Intergovernmental Agreement shall expire on June 30, 2010.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement may delay payments to Multnomah County, therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
