

Ordinance admitting Protection Fire Co No. 4 to the Portland Fire Department.

The People of the City of Portland do ordain

as follows:

Sec 1 That the Fire Company organized as Protection Fire Co. No. 4 being duly recommended by the board of Delegates for admission to the Fire Department & their constitution being duly submitted signed by upwards of thirty members over 21 years of age & residents of this City, that said Protection Fire Co. No. 4 be & is hereby admitted & constituted one of the Fire Companies of the Portland Fire Department under the name of "Protection Fire Co No. 4." subject to all the laws & regulations governing the Fire Department.

Sec 2 That said Protection Fire Co. No. 4 be & is hereby located in the third ward between Salmon & Madison streets.

Sec 3 That this ordinance take effect from & after its approval by the Mayor.
