Ordinance No 121.

An ordinance to amend an ordinance entitled an ordinance to establish the grade of Washington Street between Second Street and West Park Street:

The people of the City of Portland do ordain as follows:

Sec 1st That the grade of Washington Street at its junction with 4th Street be and is hereby established thirteen feet above the base of grade, and that the grade at the crossing of Washington and East Park Streets be and is hereby established nineteen feet above said base of grade, and that the grade at the crossing of Washington and West Park Streets be and is hereby established at twenty two feet above said base of grade.

Sec 2d That the words "from 6th Street to West Park Street, seventeen feet above the base of grade" in section one of the ordinance to establish the grade of Washington Street between 2nd Street and West Park Street be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec 3d That this ordinance take effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
