

An Ordinance adopting report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the extension of Washington Street

Whereas the Common Council of the City of Portland, deeming it expedient to establish the street of said City, known as Washington Street, from the intersection of Seventh & said Street to a point where it would intersect with 'C' Street, did on the day of _____ A.D. 1866 direct the City Surveyor of said City, to survey said street and to mark the boundaries thereof and to make his report containing a plat of the survey of said proposed street and the boundaries thereof and of the portions of each lot or part thereof to be appropriated for said Street.

And whereas said Surveyor has made said survey and report, which report is satisfactory to said Council and is herein set forth and embodied, therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows.

Sec 1. The report of C. W. Burrows City Surveyor is hereby adopted, of which the following is a copy. To the Honorable Common Council of the City of Portland Gentlemen. The proposed extension of Washington Street, westerly, is sixty (60) feet wide and is bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point where the North line of Washington Street meets the division line of the D. H. and Nancy Vonsdale Land Claim, said point is seventy six and seven tenths (76.7) feet westerly from the west line of Seventh Street. And runs thence westerly along the North line of Washington Street, produced, two thousand and twenty three and five tenths (2023.5) feet to a stake in the South line of 'B' Street and in the South line of the J. H. Couch Land Claim. Thence westerly along the South line of said Couch claim, one hundred and ninety three (193) feet to a stake. Thence easterly along the prolongation of the South line of Washington Street, two thousand two hundred and seven (2207) feet to the point where the South line of Washington Street meets said division line. Thence northerly along said division line sixty (60) feet to the place of beginning.

The following lots each thirty (30) feet wide and lying on the North side of the center line of the proposed extension of Washington Street, and adjacent thereto, will have to be appropriated: viz. A lot one hundred and fifty three and three tenths (153.3) feet long, lying between the division line of the D. H. and Nancy Vonsdale Land Claim and the center line of what is known as East Park Street. Said lot contains four thousand five hundred and ninety nine (4599) square feet.

A lot between the center lines of what are known as East and West Park Streets, one hundred and forty (140) feet long, and containing four thousand two hundred (4200) square feet.

And whereas said Surveyor has made said survey and report, which report is satisfactory to said Council and is herein set forth and embodied, therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows

Sec 1. The report of C. W. Durrage City Surveyor is hereby adopted, of which the following is a copy, To the Honorable Common Council of the City of Portland Gentlemen. The proposed extension of Washington Street, existing is sixty (60) feet wide and is bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point where the North line of Washington Street meets the division line of the D. H. and Nancy Lonsdale Land Claim (said point is seventy six and seven tenths (76.7) feet west from the west line of Seventh Street, and runs thence westerly along the North line of Washington Street, produced, two thousand and twenty three and five tenths (2223.5) feet to a stake in the South line of B Street and in the South line of the Nancy Lonsdale Land Claim. Thence westerly along the South line of said land claim, one hundred and ninety three (193) feet to a stake. Thence easterly along the prolongation of the South line of Washington Street, two thousand two hundred and seven (2207) feet to the point where the South line of Washington Street meets said division line. Thence northerly along said division line sixty (60) feet to the place of beginning.

The following lots, each thirty (30) feet wide and lying on the North side of the center line of the proposed extension of Washington Street, and adjacent thereto, will have to be appropriated: viz. A lot one hundred and fifty three and three tenths (153.3) feet long, lying between the division line of the D. H. and Nancy Lonsdale Land Claim and the center line of what is known as East Park Street. Said lot contains four thousand five hundred and ninety nine (4599) square feet.

A lot between the center lines of what are known as East and West Park Streets, one hundred and forty (140) feet long, and containing four thousand two hundred (4200) square feet.

A lot five hundred and seventy two feet long lying between the
 center line of what are known as West Park and Eighth Streets, and
 containing eight thousand and five hundred (8050) square feet.
 Two lots, each two hundred and eighty feet long, lying respectively
 between the center lines of what are known as Eighth and Ninth, and
 Ninth and Tenth Streets, each containing eight thousand four hundred

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(8400) square feet.

A lot forty (40) feet long lying between the center line of what is known
 as Third Street and the east line of Block I, containing twelve hundred

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(1200) square feet.

A strip of Block I two hundred (200) feet long and containing six thousand
 four hundred (6400) square feet.

Two lots each eighty (80) feet long being respectively parts of what are
 known as Eleventh and Twelfth Streets, and each containing two thousand

four hundred (2400) square feet.

A strip of Block I two hundred (200) feet long and containing six thousand
 four hundred (6400) square feet.

Also the various numbers of lots each thirty (30) feet wide lying on the east
 side of, and adjacent to, the center line of said proposed extension of
 Washington Street. Each lot on the south side of said center line has
 the same area as the adjacent lot on the north side.

Also a lot lying west of what is known as Twelfth Street containing
 twenty three thousand five hundred and eighty (23,580) square feet, being
 a portion of the block with that name's number lying west of Block I.

A lot two hundred and seventy (270) feet long, lying between the center lines of what are known as West Park and Eighth Streets, and containing eight thousand one hundred (8100) square feet.

Two lots, each two hundred and eighty⁽²⁸⁰⁾ feet long, lying respectively between the center lines of what are known as Eighth and Ninth, and Ninth and Tenth Streets, each containing eight thousand four hundred (8400) square feet.

A lot forty (40) feet long lying between the center line of what is known as South Street and the east line of block I, containing twelve hundred (1200) square feet.

A strip of block I two hundred (200) feet long and containing six thousand (6000) square feet.

Two lots each eighty (80) feet long being respectively parts of what was known as Eleventh and Twelfth Streets, and each containing two thousand four hundred (2400) square feet.

A strip of block J two hundred (200) feet long and containing six thousand (6000) square feet.

Also the same number of lots, each thirty (30) feet wide, lying on the south side of, and adjacent to, the center line of said proposed extension of Washington Street. Each lot on the south side of said center line has the same area as the adjacent lot on the north side.

Also a lot lying west of what is known as Twelfth Street containing twenty three thousand five hundred and eight (23,508) square feet, being a portion of the block without name or number lying west of block J.
