

An Ordinance authorizing the sale and Conveyance of Block, No. 172, to the United States Government.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the agreement made by the Mayor of the City of Portland to sell to the United States Government, Block numbered One hundred and seventy two (172) in said City for the sum of fifteen thousand (15,000) dollars, (as authorized by a resolution of the Common Council,) be and is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and empowered to execute a good and sufficient deed to the Government of the United States of America, ~~with or without Covenant, Warranty, for Block~~ numbered One hundred and Seventy two (172) according to the Map of the City, which said deed, when signed by the Mayor, shall be attested by the Auditor and Clerk, and the seal of the City thereto attached, and delivered to the proper officer or officers of the United States upon the payment of the said sum of fifteen thousand (15,000) dollars, therefore.
