An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 613 entitled "an Ordinance providing quarterly allowances for each of the several Fire Companies belonging to the Fire Department."

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

That Section 1. of Ordinance No. 613. entitled "an Ordinance providing quarterly allowances for each of the several Fire Companies belonging to the Fire Department" approved July 10. 1869. be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That each Engine Company using a Steam Fire Engine shall be allowed for ordinary expenses of the Company the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars (\$150) per quarter; for gas consumed in the Engine fire box the sum of Sixty (\$60) per quarter; for gas consumed in lighting the Engine Works fifteen (15) dollars per quarter, and for payment of an engine driver the sum of Ninety (\$90) dollars per quarter.
