

No 1039.

An Ordinance to designate the Park Blocks by letters and numbers.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows;

Section 1

That the tracts of land lying between North East Park and North West Park Streets, and the streets hereinafter named, be designated upon the maps and records of the City as follows;

The tract between A. and B. Streets as "Park Block A"; between B and C Streets as "Park Block B"; between C and D. Streets as "Park Block C"; between D. and E. Streets as "Park Block D"; between E and F Streets as "Park Block E," and between F and G Streets as "Park Block F."

Section 2

The tracts of land lying between East Park and West Park Streets, and the streets hereinafter named shall be numbered as follows;

The tract between Salmon and Main Streets as "Park Block 7"; between Main and Madison streets as "Park Block 8"; between Madison and Jefferson Street as "Park Block 9"; between Jefferson and Calma

via Street as "Park Block 10" and so on consec-
utively, to as far south as Park Street extend.
