An Ordinance making an appropriation out of the "fund for interest on bonds."

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That out of the special fund, known as the "fund for interest on bonds," there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of seven thousand six hundred and fifty dollars for payment of interest to become due during the year 1876 on certain bonds issued under the provisions of Ordinances Nos. 936 and 1350.
