All Ordinances adopting the report of the Viewers in the matter of the lateral extension or widening of Second No N Second streets at their intersection, and directing an entry of the assessment hereby made in the docket of City Taxes.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Dec 1 The Common Council of the City of Portland deeming it expedient to widen, or laterally extend the lines of Second No N Second streets in such manner as to make a more convenient intersection, did on the 19th day of March 1849, direct the City Surveyor to survey the same, and make his report with plat, which said report and plat was adopted by Ordinance No 2419, entitled "An Ordinance adopting the report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the lateral extension or widening of Second No N Second Streets at their intersection", and afterwards on the second (2nd) day of April 1849, the Common Council of the City of Portland, appointed C. M. Burrage, S. Norris and J. M. Sullivan, Viewers of the proposed extension, to meet at the office of the Auditor & Clerk of the City of Portland, on Saturday April 12th, 1849, at 10 o'clock A.M. of which due notice was given by publication in the "Daily Bee" a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Portland, in the manner provided by law, and said viewers having met at the time and place appointed, and being duly sworn have made said view, and their report thereof including an assessment of benefits and damages to certain property therein specified, which said report and assessment being satisfactory to the Common Council, is hereby adopted, of which said report and assessment, the following is a copy.

To the Hon Common Council of the City of Portland, Gentlemen.

The undersigned appointed viewers of the proposed lateral extension or widening of Second No N Second streets at their intersection in the City of Portland, by a resolution adopted by your Hon body on the 2nd day of April A.D. 1849. Respectfully report that pursuant to said resolution and notice published in the "Daily Bee" we met at the time and place appointed to wit, at the office of the Auditor & Clerk of the City of Portland, on Saturday April 12th, 1849, at 10 o'clock A.M. of said day, and being first duly sworn and furnished with a copy of the Surveyor's report and plat of said proposed extension adopted by Ordinance No 2419, entitled "An Ordinance adopting the report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the lateral extension or widening of Second No N Second Streets at their intersection", proceeded to view the proposed lateral extension of Second No N Second streets at their intersection by going over the ground and noting the condition & situation of the land to be appropriated, and upon such view, we the said viewers do assess, determine and declare the damage as well as the benefits and advantages accruing, or occasioned by the proposed lateral extension of said streets to the several pieces, parcels, or lots of land hereinafter set forth and described (in United States gold and) as follows:
