An Ordinance to repeal Ordinances Nos 2367<sup>th</sup> & 2443.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Sec 1

That it appearing that the extension of Madison street from Eighth street to Twelfth street as provided for by Ordinances Nos 2367<sup>th</sup> & 2443, will work great hardships to certain of the property owners adjacent to said streets Therefore Ordinance No 2367, entitled "An Ordinance adopting the report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the proposed extension of Madison street from the west line of Eighth street to the west line of Twelfth street" and Ordinance No 2443 entitled "An Ordinance adopting the report of the Visiter in the matter of the proposed extension of Madison street from the west line of Eighth street to the west line of Twelfth street and directing an entry of the assessment hereby made in the docket of City Lices" are hereby repealed, and the assessment and entry thereof in the Docket of City Lices is hereby cancelled.
