All O. W. W. adopting the report of the Mayor  
in the matter of the proposed extension of Front Street  
directing the duty there in the docket of City Council.

Sec. 1. The Mayor of the City of Portland, Oregon, it appears  
to extend the line of Front Street, from the south line of  
Morrison Street to the south line of Eighth Street, and  
on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of Nov. 1881, directed the City Surveyor, to survey  
the same, make the boundaries there, and make his report  
together with a plat showing the particular tracts to be so  
appropriated which said report and plat was adopted  
by Ordinance No. 3350. Intitled "An Ordinance, adopting the  
report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the proposed extension  
of Front Street from the south line of Morrison Street to the  
Eighth Street," and afterwards, to wit: on the 24<sup>th</sup> day  
of Dec. 1881, the Common Council appointed J. D.  
Allen, J. C. Pitts and Frank Lambert members of said Council  
retaining a Board of Survey to meet at the office of the Auditor  
in the Court on Saturday the 28<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1882, at 10  
o'clock a.m. for the purpose of making an assessment  
of damages and benefits, of which due notice was given by  
publication of notice in the Daily Standard, a Newspaper  
of general circulation in the City of Portland, in the manner  
provided by law; and said Council having met for the purpose  
of making said view at the time and place appointed

and being duly sworn, have made said view and their report  
thereon including an amount of damages and benefits to certain  
property therein specified which said report and assessment  
being satisfactory to the Common Council, is hereby adopted,  
of which said report the following is a copy.

In the Year, the Common Council

The undersigned ascertained various of the proposed situation  
of Front Street, in the City of Portland from the south side  
of Morrison Street, to connect with North Eighth Street. On the  
application of the City of Portland by a resolution adopted by your  
honorable body of 10 December 1881.

Respectfully report, that pursuant to said resolution  
we met at the office of the Auditor on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January  
1882, and was sworn and furnished with the City Surveyors  
report and plat of said extension, adopted by Ordinance  
No. 3350. After examining said report and plat, we proceeded  
to view said extension of Front Street by going over the  
ground and noting the condition of the same to be appropriate  
in procedure to assess, estimate and declare the bene-  
fit and advantages accruing as well as the damage  
sustained by the extension of said Front Street to the several  
parcels and tracts of land as hereinafter set forth as follows:

The damage sustained by the corner of  
A. N. King & Son of a tract of land lying between the  
east and west lines of the proposed extension  
of Front Street and between the east line  
of the A. N. King land claim and the west  
line of Block and containing five thousand  
four hundred (5,400) square feet is

The damage sustained by the corner

tween the east and west lines of the pro-  
posed extension of Front Street and  
between the west line of Front Street and  
said east end the east line of the A. N. King  
land claim, being a portion of Lot 2, 3, 7 and 1  
in Block 200 and containing one thousand three  
hundred and fifty (1,350) square feet is
