

Ordinance No 4872

An Ordinance adopting the Report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the proposed extension of Kelly street south-
erly from its present southern terminus over + across the
"Old Cemetery" to the northern end of Douglas street
The City of Portland, does ordain as follows:-

Section 1. The Common Council of the City of Portland
deeming it expedient to extend the lines of Kelly street
southerly from the southern terminus of said street across
over the Old Cemetery so as to connect with Douglas street
did on the 19th day of May, A.D. 1886 direct the City Surveyor
or to survey the same, mark the boundaries thereof submit
a Report of such survey together with a plat showing each
particular tract or parcel of land to be appropriated to
public use + the Surveyor having made such survey, report
plat + the same being satisfactory to the Common Council
said Report of W. S. Chapman, City Surveyor in the matter
of the extension of Kelly street is now therefore adopted -
of which said Report the following is a copy

To the Hon. The Common Council of the City of Portland
Remembrance.

In pursuance of a Resolution adopted at your
meeting of the 19th day of May A.D. 1886 directing me to sur-
vey and mark the boundaries of an extension of Kelly street
from its present southern terminus over + across the Old Ce-
metery to the northern end of Douglas street in said City of
Portland, I have surveyed and marked the boundaries of
such an extension of Kelly street and herein submit my
Report together with a plat of such survey.

The proposed extension of Kelly street and the tract of
land which will be included within the lines of said ex-
tension and will have to be appropriated to public use on
account of the proposed laying out, opening + establishing
of said extension of Kelly street are more particularly
bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning on the south line of the Elizabeth Thomas Don-
ation Land claim in Section No. 10 in Township No. 1 South
Range No. 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, at the point
where said line is intersected by the west line of said Kelly
street and running thence southerly along a line conforming

to a southerly extension of the west line of said Kelly street to a line which is thirty feet in right measurement westerly from and parallel with a straight line drawn from the point where the center line of said Kelly street intersects the south line of the said Thomas Donation Land Claim to the point where the center line of Douglas street intersects the south line of the Old Cemetery tract of land in James Periwiliger Donation Land Claim in the Section and Township aforesaid, thence southerly along a line thirty feet in right measurement westerly from and parallel with a straight line drawn from the point where the center line of Kelly street intersects the south line of the said Thomas Donation Land Claim to the point where the center line of Douglas street intersects the south line of the said Old Cemetery tract to the south line of said Old Cemetery tract, thence east, along the south line of the said Old Cemetery tract to a line thirty feet in right measurement easterly from and parallel with a straight line passing through the point where the center line of Kelly street intersects the south line of the said Thomas Donation Land Claim and the point where the center line of Douglas street intersects the south line of the said Old Cemetery tract, thence northerly along a line thirty feet in right measurement easterly from and parallel with a straight line passing through the point where the center line of Kelly street intersects the south line of the said Thomas Donation Land Claim and the point where the center line of Douglas street intersects the south line of the said Old Cemetery tract to the south line of the said Thomas Donation Land Claim; and thence westerly along the south line of the said Thomas Donation Land Claim to the place of beginning. The owner of which said tract of land so to be appropriated to public use is unknown and said tract contains Twenty thousand and eight hundred and Eighty (20,880) square feet. Respectfully Submitted
