ORDINANCE No. 183964

*Approve Intergovernmental Agreement with East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District to support certain Community Garden activities. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) operates a successful Community Gardens program.
- 2. The East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District (EMSWCD) wishes to provide \$50,000 to PP&R to support certain community garden activities. This financial assistance will be available for the purposes of removing pavement and amending soil for the development of new community gardens within the EMSWCD boundaries.
- 3. PP&R and EMSWCD now desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Director of Portland Parks & Recreation is authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the City, substantially in the form of the agreement attached to this Ordinance.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to allow EMSWCD to expend these funds prior to the end of the fiscal year; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
