

RESOLUTION No. **36801**

Accept the recommendations in the Electric Vehicles: The Portland Way report and direct City of Portland bureaus to implement policies, programs and strategies to promote and integrate electric vehicles into their scope of work (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the City of Portland supports strategies and technologies that promote the early adoption of electric vehicles and the creation of job opportunities in the Electric Vehicle sector;

WHEREAS, the 2009 Climate Action Plan establishes a goal of reducing local carbon emissions by 40 percent from 1990 levels by 2030 and 80 percent from 1990 levels by 2050, and reducing vehicle miles travelled by 30 percent from 2008 levels by 2030; and

WHEREAS, the City has implemented a number of innovative policies and programs to reduce greenhouse gas emissions while providing other economic and community benefits; and

WHEREAS, the 2009 Climate Action Plan contains an action item to accelerate the transition to plug-in hybrids and electric vehicles by supporting the installation of a network of electric vehicle charging stations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Portland is a leader in adopting new technologies to improve the environmental and economic performance of our municipal fleet, including an advanced fuel management system, gas-electric hybrids, using high blends of biodiesel, installing diesel emission reduction devices, and using multiple SmartCars and electric bicycles; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon has existing tax credit incentives for both residents and businesses to reduce the cost of purchasing electric vehicles and installing charging stations in Oregon.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Portland accepts the *Electric Vehicles: The Portland Way* report; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Portland City Council directs the Portland Development Commission, the Portland Bureau of Transportation, the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, the Bureau of Development Services and CityFleet to proceed with implementation of the strategies outlined in *Electric Vehicles: The Portland Way*, and to report back to Council on the progress of that implementation by June, 2011.
