Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University to plan and implement stewardship activities (Ordinance).

804. 108

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On March 8, 2006, the Council adopted the 2005 Portland Watershed Management Plan, which describes actions for watershed health including citizen led activities such as stormwater management, revegetation, education, involvement and stewardship.
- 2. Portland State University (PSU) has mutual interests with the city related to improving watersheds and involving students and community members in the care of watersheds. PSU has been partnering with the city on the Community Watershed Stewardship Grant Program since 1995 when the first Intergovernmental Agreement was approved by City Council.
- 3. BES and PSU have agreed to continue this partnership through the attached Intergovernmental Agreement. PSU will provide three graduate assistants over a two year period. Two graduate students will coordinate the Community Watershed Stewardship Grant Program and one graduate student will support Willamette Watershed Program stewardship activities.
- 4. The established cost is \$58,000 per year for two years. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010-2011 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Centers ESWS000007 (Amount \$35,000) and ESWS000006 (Amount \$25,000) Account 529000 and FY 2011-2012 Cost Centers ESWS000007 (Amount \$35,000) and ESWS000006 (Amount \$25,000) Account 529000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Bureau of Environmental Services Director is authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Portland State University for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$58,000 per year for FY 2010-2011 and FY 2011-2012.
- b. The Bureau of Environmental Services Director is authorized to execute future amendments to this agreement that do not increase the agreement amount by more than 25% of the original agreement amount.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
