

ORDINANCE No. 183986

Authorize an Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement with the Regional Coalition for Clean Rivers and Streams to coordinate, develop and implement a regional stormwater pollution prevention and fish protection public awareness and education program.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland; Clean Water Services; Clackamas County Service District 1, Surface Water Agency of Clackamas County; Multnomah County, the City of Vancouver, Washington; Clark County, Washington; and Metro have formed the Regional Coalition for Clean Rivers and Streams (Coalition). Members of the Coalition have public education requirements under the National Pollutant Discharge and Elimination System (NPDES) stormwater permits to conduct public awareness and education activities.
2. The Coalition believes it is in the best interests of all to coordinate, develop and implement a regional stormwater pollution prevention and fish restoration and habitat protection public awareness and media campaign to promote ways to protect and improve water quality, address stormwater runoff pollution problems, and respond to Endangered Species Act listings.
3. In an effort to educate the public about stormwater pollution prevention and fish protection activities on a regional scale, the Coalition cooperatively funds a public awareness and education program. In doing so, the effort reduces duplication of services in the region and demonstrates a cooperative and coordinated effort to educate the public about issues that are regional in scope.
4. This agreement will be the fourth, five-year agreement to carry out this coordinated program. Each member adopts the agreement and, based on population statistics, funds a portion of the program.
5. The Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement describes this public awareness and education program and is for a term of 5 years. The annual cost of the program to be shared by the Coalition is \$72,000.
6. The annual cost for the City of Portland is \$19,498. Total cost over the five year term of the agreement will be \$ 97,490. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2009-2014 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center ESDR000003, Account No. 529000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Director of Environmental Services and Auditor are authorized to execute an agreement with the Regional Coalition for Clean Rivers and Streams for the purpose described in Section 1.

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- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
