ORDINANCE NO. 183987

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality for investigation and cleanup of ground water contamination in or near Columbia South Shore Well Field (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland owns and operates a large municipal water supply well field, the Columbia South Shore Well Field.
- 2. The City of Portland Water Bureau (PWB) and the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality have previously entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement known as the Remediation Partnership Agreement, initially authorized by Ordinance 176016, dated October 17, 2001. This agreement institutionalized the working relationship between the two parties with regard to the investigation and cleanup of groundwater contamination in and near the City's well field.
- 3. The most recent amendment to this Intergovernmental Agreement expires on June 30, 2010. The PWB and the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality will amend and renew the agreement.
- 4. The Groundwater Program budget includes approximately 0.5 FTE for activities related to groundwater monitoring and remediation, and coordination with ODEQ. Funds are available in the FY 2010-11 Budget, and will be requested in subsequent budget requests.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge of the Water Bureau is hereby authorized and directed to enter into and sign the Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the Intergovernmental Agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. Amendments to the agreement may be executed by the Water Bureau Administrator. Any increase exceeding twenty-five percent of the total compensation would need City Council approval.
