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ORDINANCE NO. 13055.

An ordinance providing for the submission of plans and specifications for buildings within the fire limits of the City of Portland, to the Board of Fire Commissioners.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to erect any building or buildings within the fire limits of the City of Portland without first having the plans and specifications for such building approved by the Board of Fire Commissioners.

Section 2: Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance or failing to comply

with the terms thereof shall upon conviction before the Municipal Court be fined by a fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding sixty days.
