Ordinance No. 14026.

An Ordinance concerning offenses and disorderly conduct.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That any person who shall on the streets of the City throw upon any person Confetti or other material of a similar character or who shall thrust a feather duster in any person's face, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Municipal Court shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00, or shall be imprisoned in the City Jail not less than five nor more than 25 days.
