

An Ordinance declaring the cost of constructing a sewer in East Fourteenth Street, from 75' north of north line of Weidler Street to a connection with the sewer in Multnomah Street, assessing the property benefited thereby and directing an entry of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: The sum of \$901.80 is hereby declared to be the whole cost of constructing a sewer in East Fourteenth Street, from 75' north of north line of Weidler Street to a connection with the sewer in Multnomah Street in the manner provided by Ordinance No. 14804, and the lots, parts of lots and parcels of land within the assessment district are hereby declared and found to be benefited to the full amount of said cost, and said sum is hereby assessed to the several lots and parts of lots and parcels of land in the respective amounts set opposite the number and description thereof, in assessment Roll No 64, as being benefited by said sewer, in said amounts and said Assessment Roll numbered 64 is hereby adopted and approved and the Auditor of the City of Portland is hereby directed to enter a statement of the assessment hereby made in the Docket of City Liens, and cause notice thereof to be published as provided by the City Charter.
