1) Legislation Title:

* Authorize an intergovernmental agreement between the City, the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District and the City of Beaverton (Ordinance)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

It is the intent of this agreement to assign one or more Beaverton Police Officers to Transit Police. Transit Police is managed by the Portland Police Bureau, and staffed by officers from several jurisdictions. Beaverton will pay the salaries, overtime, insurance, retirement and other benefits and indirect (overhead) charges. Beaverton will invoice TriMet for services provided by the City of Beaverton. Future staffing levels may be adjusted by agreement of the City of Portland, City of Beaverton and TriMet under the authority of the commander of the Transit Police Division.
