

ORDINANCE NO. 184008

Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the Water/Sewer Fixture Repair Program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 38116)

**The City of Portland ordains:**

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland Water Bureau (City) provides financial assistance to eligible low income households for property side plumbing repairs, which will support the City's water conservation efforts and reduce user water and sewer costs.
2. The City entered into Intergovernmental Agreement No. 38116 via Ordinance 181959 with Multnomah County (County) to acquire program administration services for the Water/Sewer Fixture Repair Program.
3. The City desires to amend the existing Intergovernmental Agreement with the County to provide continued administration of eligibility verification and coordinate repairs for the Water/Sewer Bill Fixture Repair Program.
4. The Intergovernmental Agreement shall be amended to increase the budget by \$125,000. The new agreement total will be \$250,000.
5. Funding is available in the FY 2010-11 Budget and additional funding will be requested in the FY 2011-12 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to execute on behalf of the City the amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to continue to provide administration of eligibility verification and coordinate repairs for the Water/Sewer Fixture Repair Program attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to Multnomah County, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities, chargeable to internal order 9WACS0000336.
