

ORDINANCE No. 184022

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Port of Portland for the Regional Small Business Mentoring Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Port of Portland (Port) has an established program that for many years has provided skill mentoring to selected protégés, such as small businesses including minority, women and emerging small business enterprises.
2. One of the recommendations of the 1995 Disparity Study was that the City participates in the Port's Mentoring Program. That recommendation was accepted by the City and made a part of the City's Fair Contracting and Employment Strategy, which was adopted by Council.
3. As a result of that participation, the City funded several protégé positions so that additional businesses could participate in the Port's program. The City also has been part of the Mentor/Protégé Advisory Committee for the past 13 years and will remain a part of that Committee.
4. Funds were allocated to Procurement Services, through the 2010-2011 budget process. This will allow the City to continue participating in this program.
5. The original authorization for the City's execution of an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) expires June 30, 2010, and a new ordinance is required to continue the City's participation. The proposed IGA is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit-A.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) is hereby authorized to execute an IGA with the Port in a form substantially in accordance with the IGA attached hereto as Exhibit-A.
- b. The CPO is authorized to extend this IGA, for up to 5 additional years, provided the funding is approved by City Council for each budget year.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent any delays in the progress of the Regional Small Business Mentoring Program; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Council.
