## **ORDINANCE No.** 184023

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Housing Authority of Portland for the City Workforce Training and Hiring Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City has a compelling governmental interest in facilitating the full participation of all persons in opportunities generated by the City's public works contracts, as detailed in the 1993 and 1995 "Fair Contracting and Employment Initiatives" previously adopted by the City Council.
- 2. The Housing Authority of Portland (HAP) is interested in continuing the workforce training program that is administered by the City. To facilitate HAP's cooperation in the areas of construction and nondiscrimination, an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) has been developed to assist in the continuation of the Workforce Training and Hiring Program.
- 3. The proposed IGA would permit the City to provide training and assistance services to HAP. In return, HAP will coordinate this program with the City and provide funding to the City in the sum of \$40,000. The IGA will expire December 31, 2010.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) is authorized to execute an IGA, in a form substantially in accordance with the IGA attached hereto as Exhibit-A.
- b. The CPO is authorized to extend this IGA for up to five additional years.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent the progress of the Workforce Training and Hiring Program; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and in effect after its passage by the Council.
