

Ordinance No 18153

An Ordinance vacating that part of Sumner Street lying between Blocks "A" and "B" in Walnut Park and the east line of Congress Street and the West line of Commercial Street, all in the City of Portland in Multnomah County, Oregon.

WHEREAS, due notice was given by advertisement thereof for more than four consecutive weeks, to-wit: From the 22nd day of June A D 1908, to the 22nd day of July, A D 1908, inclusive, in the official newspaper of the City of Portland, to-wit: The Daily Abstract published in said City, that at a regular meeting of the Council of said City to be held on Wednesday, the 22nd day of July, A D 1908, a petition would be presented to said Council praying for the vacation of that part of Sumner Street lying between Blocks "A" and "B" in Walnut Park and the east line of Congress Street and the west line of Commercial Street, all in the City of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, which said notice with proof of its publication is filed in the office of the Auditor of said City together with said petition. And.

WHEREAS, said petition was duly presented to said Council on the 22nd day of July A D 1908, and said petition duly set forth a description of that part of Sumner Street sought to be vacated and the reason for such vacation, to which there was appended, as a part thereof and as a basis for such vacation and for the granting of the prayer of said petition, the consent of the owners in fee simple of all of the real estate fronting on that part of Sumner Street sought to be vacated as well as the consent of all of the owners of all of the real property fronting on both sides of said Sumner Street northerly and southerly from the termini of that part of said Sumner street sought to be vacated for a distance of over two hundred (200) feet, which consent of said owners was duly acknowledged before Notaries Public for the State of Oregon and filed with the Auditor of the City of Portland, all as required by the Charter of said City. And

WHEREAS, the said Council upon the presentation of said petition and the filing of the proof of the publication of said notice did fix the first regular meeting of the Council on Wednesday, the 12th day of August A D 1908, at the regular time and place of meeting as the time for hearing said petition and objections thereto. And

WHEREAS, said Council has ascertained and determined and does cause it to be made a matter of record that all of the hereinbefore recited acts and things have been done, and that the consent of the owners of all of the real property fronting on said Sumner Street and part thereof sought to be vacated required by the Charter of said City has been duly obtained, and that the public interests would not be prejudiced by the vacation of that part of Sumner Street aforesaid sought to be vacated, and the said Council so finding. And

WHEREAS, no objections have been filed to said petition or to the vacation of said Sumner Street as therein prayed for.

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That that part of Sumner Street lying between Blocks "A" and "B" in Walnut Park and the east line of Congress Street and the west line of Commercial Street, all in the City of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, be and the same hereby is vacated.
