* Apply for a \$50,000 grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2010 for the Gang Resistance Education and Training Program (Ordinance)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

The City of Portland, Oregon Police Bureau wishes to apply for \$50,000 in grant funding, which will aid in the delivery of the Elementary and Middle School curricula as well as the G.R.E.A.T. Families and Summer Components. The grant period is October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011.
