ORDINANCE No. 184036

*Amend ordinance to include indemnification to the Portland Public Schools Rights of Entry in connection with the Safe Routes to School Project (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 183542)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland Bureau of Transportation has initiated a project that implement pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements to eleven elementary schools City wide. The project improvements will include sidewalk infill, curb extensions, median refuge islands, countdown pedestrian signal heads and curb ramps.
- 2. Portland Public Schools has agreed to convey the needed Right of Entry to the City, subject to indemnification from the City.
- 3. The Office of the City Attorney has reviewed this matter and recommends that the City approve the rights of entry with the addition of indemnification language.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City Engineer is hereby authorized to execute the easement with Portland Public Schools, in substantially the same form as the easement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. All remaining portions of Ordinance No. 183542 shall remain unchanged and all conditions thereof shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in property acquisition at this location will result in a construction delay of the Safe Routes to School Project and overall project completion; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
