ORDINANCE No. 184039

*Amend contract with Brown and Caldwell for additional work and compensation for the Fanno Basin Pump Station Project No. E08294 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 37106)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of continuing professional engineering services provided by Brown and Caldwell (B&C) for the completion of design work for required Fanno Basin System Improvements projects.
- 2. B & C is continuing to provide professional engineering services under Contract No. 37106, effective December 4, 2006 with an expiration date of December 03, 2011.
- 3. Additional engineering investigations and BES flow modeling of the Fanno Basin systems have concluded that a number of additional project elements are required to resolve the deficiencies in the Fanno Basin (FABA) pump station and pressure line system.
- 4. The estimated cost of this contract amendment is \$725,727. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Projects E08294, E09050, E09051, E09052, and E09168. The level of confidence in the negotiated cost for the proposed amendment 6 to contract No. 37106 with Brown and Caldwell is high.
- 5. M/W/ESB participation after the authorization of this contract amendment will be \$1,194,295, 32.6% of the total amended contract amount of \$3,665,250.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute amendment 6 to Contract 37106 with Brown and Caldwell for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$725,727.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the Fanno Basin pump station and pressure line system is currently inoperable due to multiple localized failures, and all Fanno Basin flow is being diverted to Clean Water Services (CWS) resulting in significant costs to the City of Portland. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
