*Extend contract with Camp Dresser McKee, Inc. for electrical engineering services for a Garage Lighting Replacement Study (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 36360)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City entered into Contract No. 36360 with Camp Dresser McKee, Inc. in the amount of \$50,000 on November 22, 2005 to provide electrical engineering services under a PTE flexible services contract with an original expiration date of August 11, 2008.
- 2. This contract was the result of a Request for Proposals (BGS006) issued on June 9, 2005, in which the five highest scoring electrical engineering consultants were awarded contracts.
- 3. Two Amendments have been issued against this contract, each extending the expiration date by one year. The current expiration date is August 11, 2010. Two Task Orders totaling \$42,241 have been issued against this contract.
- 4. Per City Charter Section 2-105(a)(3), the City of Portland, Office of Management and Finance, wishes to amend Contract No. 36360 (attached as Exhibit A), to extend the termination date beyond five years for an additional one year period, or until August 11, 2011 to allow for completion of electrical engineering services for a Garage Lighting Replacement Study for four (4) City owned parking facilities.
- 5. This amendment does not change the total compensation of the contract which remains at \$50,000 with a current balance of \$7,759. The cost of using this contract to complete the work has been budgeted as part of the Garage Lighting Replacement Project.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to amend Contract No. 36360, Exhibit A attached, with Camp Dresser McKee, Inc. to extend the termination date for an additional one year period, or until August 11, 2011 to allow for completion of electrical engineering services for the Garage Lighting Replacement Project.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the budget of Facilities Services when demand is presented and approved by appropriate authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid a lapse in the contract; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
