

Ordinance No. 19821

An Ordinance designating a site for a fire engine house and park.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and advisable to construct a fire engine house in northern Albina, and also to provide more parks for the residents in said locality, and

WHEREAS the south one-half of Block "B" Patton's Tract, was purchased by the Water Department and is owned by the City, and

WHEREAS said one-half of Block "B" is not used by the Water Department;
therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the northwest 100 feet by 100 feet of the south one-half of Block "B" Patton's Tract, be and the same is hereby designated as a site for a fire engine house.

Section 2: That the south one-half of Block "B" Patten's Tract, except the northwest 100 feet by 100 feet, which is reserved for a site for a fire engine house, be and is hereby designated as a site for a City Park.
