

Ordinance No. 19972

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to purchase lot 11, Mount Tabor Park, for park purposes, at a price exceeding the amount heretofore authorized under the provisions of Ordinance No. 19272.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Ordinance No. 19272 the Mayor and Auditor were authorized to draw a warrant on the Park and Boulevard Fund in the sum of \$3250.00, to provide for the payment of lot 11, Mount Tabor Park, and

WHEREAS, a report of the Committee on Parks and Public Property was adopted by the Council May 26, 1909, recommending that the sum of \$3700.00 be paid for said property, reserving to the owner the privilege to remove the house situated thereon; therefore,

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to draw a warrant on the Park and Boulevard Fund in favor of the owner of lot 11, Mount Tabor Park, in the sum of thirty-seven hundred dollars, (\$3700.00), said amount being \$450.00 in addition to the amount heretofore authorized under the provisions of Ordinance No. 19272; said warrant to be drawn in favor of the owner of the property mentioned upon the delivery of an abstract having attached thereto the certificate of the City Attorney that the title to said property is clear and free from all incumbrances.

Section 2. Whereas there is an immediate necessity that this ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor, an emergency is hereby declared and said ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of

Portland for the following reasons: That only one location is available for park purposes in this neighborhood and the opportunity is now afforded to secure said location, and if this opportunity is not embraced the City is liable to lose a considerable amount of money in acquiring said property at a later date. Therefore this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
