An Ordinance adopting the report of the Viewers in the matter of the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Killingsworth Avenue from the east line of Union Avenue, to the east line ~~Street~~ of Sections 15 and 24 T 1 N R 1 E W N

making an assessment of the benefits and damages set forth in said report.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

WHEREAS, The Council, deeming it expedient to open, lay out and establish Killingsworth Avenue from the east line of Union Avenue to the east line of Sections 15 and 24 T 1 N R 1 E W N ~~Street~~

did, on the 12th day of August 1908, direct the City

Engineer to survey the same, and to mark the boundaries thereof, and to make a plat of such survey, and a written report containing a full and perfect description of such proposed Avenue ~~and~~ and the boundaries thereof and of the portion of each lot, tract,

or part of either to be appropriated for such streets, and the City Engineer having made such survey, plat and report and filed such plat and report in the office of the Auditor of the City of Portland on the 21st August 1908

and the same being satisfactory to the Council, was adopted, by Ordinance No. 18303 entitled: "An Ordinance adopting the report of the City Engineer in

the matter of the proposed ~~opening, laying out and estab-~~
lishing of Killingsworth Avenue from the east line of ~~Street~~
Union Avenue to the east line of Sections 13 and 24 Township 1
North Range 1 East Willamette Meridian*

and afterwards on the 24th day of September 1908 by resolution,
appointed T Dinneen, J Keating and W W Terry
~~and~~ viewers of the said proposed
opening, laying out and establishing of Killingsworth Avenue

~~at~~

~~Street~~

to meet at the office of the Auditor of the City of Portland, on the 15th
day of October 1908 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon of said day for the
purpose of viewing said proposed street and making an assessment of the benefits and
damages occasioned by such proposed opening, laying out and estab-
lishing of Killingsworth Avenue of which
due notice was given in the manner provided by law by publication of notice in the
"Portland Daily Abstract" a newspaper of general circulation
published in the City of Portland, as will more fully appear by the proof thereof duly
presented and filed in the office of the Auditor of the City of Portland, and said Viewers
having met for the purpose of making said view and assessment at the time and place
appointed and on that and subsequent days to which they adjourned, not exceeding one
week, having made such view and assessment of benefits and damages, and the same
being satisfactory to the Council;

Now, therefore, The report of T Dinneen, J Keating
and W W Terry viewers of the proposed opening, laying
out and establishing of Killingsworth Avenue
