An Ordinance adopting the report of the Viewers in the matter of the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Killingsworth Avenue from the east line of Union Avenue, to the east line of Sections 10 and 24 T 1 N R 1 E W M Street.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

WHEREAS, The Council, deeming it expedient to open, lay out and establish Killingsworth Avenue from the east line of Union Avenue to the east line of Sections 10 and 24 T 1 N R 1 E W M Street,

did, on the 12th day of August 1908, direct the City

Engineer to survey the same, and to mark the boundaries thereof, and to make a plat of such survey, and a written report containing a full and perfect description of such pro-

posed Avenue and the boundaries thereof and of the portion of each lot, tract, or part of either to be appropriated for such streets and the City Engineer having made

such survey, plat and report and filed such plat and report in the office of the Auditor

appointed and on that and subsequent days to which they adjourned, not exceeding one

week, having made such view and assessment of benefits and damages, and the same

being satisfactory to the Council;
