Ordinance No. 20615

An Ordinance taking over a County Road known as Macadam Street, from the north line of Section 15, Township 1 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian to the southern boundary of the City, as a City Street.

Whereas, the County Court of Multnomah County, State of Oregon, on January 28th, 1910, surrendered a County Road known as Macadam Street, from the north line of Section 15, Township 1 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian to the southern boundary of the City, to the City of Portland as and for a City Street, therefore

THE CITY OF PORTLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the County Road, known as Macadam Street, from the north line of Section 15, Township 1 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian to the southern boundary of the City, be and the same is hereby taken over and established as a City Street, as described in the report of the City Engineer adopted by Ordinance No. 20616.
