

Ordinance No. 20845

An Ordinance adopting the report of the City Engineer in the matter of the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of East Twenty-sixth

Street,
from the south line of Division Street to the south line
of Simon's Addition, extended easterly.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

WHEREAS, The Council, of the City of Portland deeming it expedient to open, lay out and establish East Twenty-sixth Street
from the south line of Division

Street,

to the south line of Simon's Addition, extended easterly

did, on the 26th day of January 1901, direct the City

Engineer to survey the same, and to mark the boundaries thereof, and to make a plat of such survey, and a written report containing a full and perfect description of such proposed street and the boundaries thereof and of the portion of each lot, tract,

or part of either to be appropriated for such street, and the City Engineer having made such survey, plat and report and filed such plat and report in the office of the Auditor

of the City of Portland on the 7th day of February 1901

and the said plat and report being satisfactory to the Council, is now hereby adopted,

To the Honorable Mayor and Council

of the City of Portland.

Gentlemen:

In pursuance of a Resolution adopted by your Honorable Body at your meeting of Jan. 26, 1910, directing me to survey and mark the boundaries of a proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of East 26th Street in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, from the South line of Division Street to the South line of Simon's Addition, thence easterly; said street to be 60 feet wide, the center line of same to be the West line of Clinton Kelly Donation Land Claim. I have surveyed and marked the boundaries of the proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of East 26th Street, and herein submit my report together with a plat of said survey. The proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of East 26th Street is 60 feet in width and is more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the South line of Division Street 30 feet West of the West line of the Clinton Kelly Donation Land Claim, and running thence southerly 30 feet westerly from and parallel with the West line of said Clinton Kelly Donation Land Claim, to the South line of the Simon's Addition; thence along the South line of Simon's Addition and an easterly extension thereof 60 feet; thence northerly 60 feet easterly from and parallel with the West line of the proposed opening. Laying-out and establishing of East 26th Street as above described, to the South line of Division Street; thence West along the South line of Division Street 60 feet to the place of beginning.

The proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of East 26th Street as above described, will include and necessitate the appropriation to public use, the following described parcels or tracts of land, to wit:

All that part of the following lots lying East of the West line of the proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of East 26th Street, as above described:
