

To the Honorable Mayor and Council

of the City of Portland.

Gentlemen:

In pursuance of a Resolution adopted by your Honorable Body at your meeting of February 11, 1910, directing me to survey and mark the boundaries of a proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of Boulevard in Fulton Park, from the westerly line of Taylor's Ferry Road to the westerly line of Corbett Street, by taking the same over from a County Road to a City Street.

I have surveyed and marked the boundaries of the proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of Boulevard, and herein submit my report together with a plat of said survey. The proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of Boulevard is 40 feet in width and is more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the south corner of Block G., Fulton Park and running thence northerly and westerly along the northerly and easterly line of Boulevard to the northeast corner of Block 48, Fulton Park; thence east along the north line of Fulton Park 60 feet; thence southerly and easterly 40 feet distant from and parallel with the northerly and easterly line of Boulevard as above described, to the west line of Taylor's Ferry Road; thence northerly along the west line of Taylor's Ferry Road 100 feet more or less to the place of beginning.

The proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of Boulevard as above described, will include and necessitate the appropriation to public use as a City Street, all of the proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of Boulevard as above described, now used and occupied as a County Road.
