ORDINANCE No. 108069


An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to execute an agreement between the City and Multnomah County for insect control service by the City for one year commencing July 1, 1958, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that the present agreement between the City of Portland and Multnomah County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, whereby the City provides insect control service by means of spraying from aircraft and ground equipment and is reimbursed by Multnomah County for the cost of such service, expires June 30, 1958; that such agreement has been in the public interest for the people of the City of Portland in that such insect control in the County area provides the most efficient means of preventing and controlling insects within the City; that an agreement should be entered into whereby such insect control service will be extended for one year commencing July 1, 1958; now, therefore, the Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to execute and deliver an agreement, substantially in accordance with the agreement attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and by this reference made a part hereof, whereby the City of Portland will perform insect control service for Multnomah County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, for a period of one year commencing July 1, 1958, at a cost to be reimbursed by the County.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there be no lapse of time in the insect control now maintained in the County area under agreement ending June 30, 1958; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

A G R E E M E N T

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between MULTNOMAH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Board of Commissioners, hereinafter called "County" and the CITY OF PORTLAND, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Mayor and Auditor, hereinafter called "City",

W I T N E S S E T H:

For and in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein contained, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. City agrees to perform insect control service in Multnomah County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, by means of spraying from aircraft and ground equipment at such places and at such times as the City shall determine to be necessary up to a total cost of \$_____.

2. County agrees to pay for City's work and materials a sum not exceeding said amount of \$_____ upon presentation of a bill therefor by the City.

3. County agrees to save City harmless from any claim for damages to person or property resulting from the use of aircraft (beyond the limits of insurance coverage maintained by City, in the use of spray materials and insecticides, and in the entry of agents and employes of City in any inspection work upon land and water located in County for the purpose of determining need for and effectiveness of control measures.

4. This agreement is made pursuant to the provisions of ORS 452.210 to 452.250 inclusive, and the officers, agents and employes of City hereby are vested with the same right of entry, inspection and treatment given County under said statutes.

5. This agreement is for the period from July 1, 1958 through June 30, 1959.

Subject Renewal of Mosquito Control Contract between City of Portland and Multnomah County

May 19, 1958

Dear Mayor Schruck:

The existing contract with Multnomah County for mosquito control services will expire on June 30, 1958. This contract was drawn to cover a short period from December 1, 1957 through June 30, 1958 in order for future contracts to coincide with the fiscal budget year.

It is recommended that a new agreement be executed between the City of Portland and Multnomah County for the period from July 1, 1958 through June 30, 1959, with the payment to be the amount authorized by the 1958-59 budget. This will replace Agreement # 8964 under Ordinance # 107541 passed by the Council March 5, 1958.

Dear Mayor Schrunk:

We have prepared and submit herewith ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to execute an agreement between the City and Multnomah County for insect control service by City for one year commencing July 1, 1958.

The contract amount has been left blank in the attached agreement (Exhibit "A"). The Board of County Commissioners propose to spend \$31,615 on mosquito control. However, since the amount is now only tentative, it may be inserted at the time the agreement is executed pursuant to their resolution.
