



ORDINANCE No. **118001**

An Ordinance accepting a deed for a portion of Lot 2, Madison Villa, granted by Clement E. Weber and Erna Weber for the widening of S.W. Hume Street East of S.W. 30th Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:


Section 1. That the deed for the following described property be and is hereby accepted for street purposes:

North 5.0 feet of the north 100 feet of the west 100 feet of Lot 2, Madison Villa. (Granted by Clement W. Weber and Erna Weber, 2700 S.W. Hume Street)

Section 2. That the City Auditor be and he is hereby directed to have the deed for street purposes as described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record and a copy of this ordinance forwarded to the County Assessor.


Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: To avoid any unnecessary delay in making this right of way a matter of record; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
